- SOIL HEALTH PROGRAM: Organizes farmers and landowners to increase the number of farmers in the Upper Midwest implementing soil-building methods through field days, learning hubs, workshops, and on-farm research.
- REGIONAL FOOD SYSTEMS PROGRAM: Organizes communities to expand local and regional food systems in which food is grown with high levels of environmental stewardship, an increasing number of people gain affordable access to good food grown in the region, and in which inequities in the food system are addressed.



### ABOUT LSP

- FARM BEGINNINGS PROGRAM: Train aspiring, beginning, + established farmers on how to successfully start + sustain a farm, economically, environmentally, + socially.
- LAND ACCESS PROGRAM: Organize landowners, retiring farmers, and emerging farmers to create pathways for transitioning farmland to people who want to farm. Support the leadership of Black, Brown, Indigenous, and immigrant organizations in addressing histoical and present land ownership inequities.



# REGIONAL FOOD SYSTEMS


When we build robust community-based food systems, we are creating <u>strong</u>, <u>resilient</u>, and <u>interconnected communities</u>.


